

# **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Global Pandemic**

## **Special Notice**

**(13/3/2020)**

If you have travelled overseas and returned to Australia in the past month, you are required to self-isolate at home for at least 14 days, or for a longer period of time, to ensure that you have no symptoms of having been infected with COVID-19 before joining any of our church events. The self-isolation period is calculated from the day you arrive in Australia.

If you have friends or relatives visiting from mainland China, South Korea, Japan, United States, South Asia, Middle East, North Africa, and Europe, and have close contact with you, you are required to isolate yourself for at least 14 days, or for a longer period of time, as a precautionary measure during the pandemic and also doing our duty of loving our neighbours, to ensure that you have no symptoms of having been infected with COVID-19 before joining any of our church events.

*At this critical time, it is necessary to be proactive in putting in place these precautionary measures to protect the well-being of people in our church and in the wider community. The entire church is required to close if one person in our church community is diagnosed with COVID-19. We highly appreciate your understanding and cooperation.*

*Brothers and sisters who choose to stay at home can join our church service through live broadcast. We also encourage our cell groups to stay connected, support and pray for one another via technology.*

During the self-isolation period, you should regularly check your physical health every day for any symptoms such as runny nose, sore throat, fever, cough, difficulty in breathing, vomiting and diarrhea. If you show any sign of symptoms, please consult your family doctor immediately.
