God's household is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth. (1 Timothy 3:15b)

Day 1: Pray for CCBC (1)

1. Pray for the renewal and growth of various ministries. May God guide our way and provide what is required!
2. May God use the Joint Cell Bible Study to help brothers & sisters to understand the truth and apply it in daily life.
3. Pray for our pastors, leaders & helpers serving diligently in various ministries. May God guard them and their families, keep them well and increase their wisdom, faith & perseverance.
4. Pray for our brothers & sisters, their relatives & friends who are sick. May the Lord's healing hand be upon them, provide them with all their needs and comfort their families! Pray also for our pastors who look after them diligently.
5. Pray for the elderly parents of our brothers & sisters, especially those living far away. Pray for God's care and protection!
6. Pray for the brothers & sisters looking for work. May God open doors for them and provide for their daily needs!
7. We do not have enough space for running simultaneous onsite gatherings. May God provide more space for a variety of our ministries!

8. May the Lord provide more helpers to welcome newcomers and help them know our church better!

9. Pray for the implementation of various child safety measures. Pray that all our brothers & sisters will join together in providing a safer place for children!

10. Pray to ask God to bind Satan and block the destructive works, strengthen the faith of brothers & sisters, and help them stay alert in prayers.

Day 2: Pray for local community missions CareNet

1. Pray for the preparation of the "Cognitive Impairment Series 2" online health seminar, which will be held on May 13th. Ask the Lord to use this event to help the participants gain a better understanding of this condition and learn how to care for those who suffer from it.
2. Remember the families of the patients currently under CareNet's care. Pray that they may experience the Lord's presence, peace and strength, and that their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs may be met.
3. Pray for CareNet's financial needs and ask the Lord to provide more regular donors to support its daily operations.

Day 3: Global Missions –

Anna (HK Local Cross-Cultural Missions)

1. Thank God for the smooth furlough early this year, experiencing His protection and care throughout the journey.
2. On March 19, 100 Indonesian domestic helpers participated in the outreach event "Noah's Ark Day Trip" and responded very positively. Pray that God will continue to help the participating churches follow up with the new sisters they have contacted, and that the gospel message shared that day will take root in their hearts.
3. Thank God that some of the sisters in the English class are gradually opening up to the gospel. Please uphold sister D with prayers that she may have a clear understanding of Jesus and accept Him as her personal Saviour.
4. Starting on March 22, Muslims began a month-long period of fasting, during which they refrain from food and drink from sunrise to sunset each day and focus on prayer in an effort to cleanse their sins. Pray that God will speak to them during this time and help them get to know that only Jesus is the true Saviour.

Day 4: Pray for Christians under Persecutions

Around the world, persecutions directed at Christians are becoming more blatant. Please read the 2023 World Watch List and pray earnestly for the Christians in **Myanmar** which ranks **#14** on the list of the 50 most dangerous countries to follow Jesus.

Day 5: Pray for People in Sufferings around the World

Pray for the global pandemic situation:

More than 700 million people have been infected with COVID-19 worldwide, and **more than 6.8 million** people have lost their lives since the beginning of the pandemic. May the Lord have mercy!

Different parts of the world are still suffering from the pandemic. Please keep praying.

1. May God give wisdom to the vaccine researchers, so that the vaccines and other medications can be effective in fighting against new variants!
2. We pray that the needs of the poorer countries would also be taken into consideration, so that all people across the world are being looked after.
3. The pandemic has impacted children all over the world, especially in those poverty-stricken countries. May God protect them, secure them from danger and enable them to continue their studies, so that their growth will not be stunted!

Pray for Australia

1. Many people are impacted mentally and emotionally by the pandemic, and psychiatrists are already seeing more people seeking help. May the Lord have mercy and give them peace!
2. Pray for the economic situation and livelihood of all people in Australia.
3. Pray for the federal & state governments of Australia. May the leaders fear God, act according to biblical truth and values, and govern the country with wisdom and love for people!

Day 6: Pray for the Nations and People

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people. (Proverbs 14:34)

- Pray for the leaders of all the nations. May they fear God; act according to biblical truth and values; govern their countries with wisdom and love for their people, so that people can live peacefully and steadily with godliness and solemnness, and come to know Lord Jesus!
- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's righteousness and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness!
- Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people – inflation & food crisis.
- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.
- Pray for the island nations in the South Pacific.
- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan and East Asia.
- Pray for a variety of global situations & needs.

(Note: There are numerous prayer items. It is not feasible to list and write out all of them comprehensively. When you pray, please include your own prayer items as various situations unfold, and pray earnestly according to personal convictions.)

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior. (1 Timothy 2:1-3)

Day 7: Great Souls at Prayer 2023 (15)

O Lord of heaven and earth, we are truly sorry for all our wrong doings; we utterly renounce whatever is contrary to your will and devote ourselves entirely to the obedience thereof. O most merciful Father, please accept this renewed dedication we make of our whole person to you. And grant that we may be able every day to offer up ourselves more sincerely and cheerfully to you; with more pure affection, hearty devotion,

and ready disposition to your service. Preserve in our minds a grateful sense of your mighty love, that we may follow the teaching and example of your son Jesus Christ. Grant that we may be like Him, pure and undefiled, meek and gentle, peaceable and patient, contented and thankful. Fulfill us all the gracious promises that He has made to us. Let it be unto your servants according to His word. Amen.
