God's household is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth. (1 Timothy 3:15b)

Day 1: Pray for CCBC (1)

1. Pray for the renewal and growth of various ministries. May God guide our way and provide what is required!

2. Pray that God will use the discipleship life practices (spiritual disciplines) in each zone this year, so that brothers & sisters walk in Christ, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, abounding in thanksgiving.

3. Pray for our pastors, leaders & helpers serving diligently in various ministries. May God guard them and their families, keep them well and increase their wisdom, faith & perseverance.

4. Pray for our brothers & sisters, their relatives & friends who are sick. May the Lord's healing hand be upon them, provide them with all their needs and comfort their families! Pray also for our pastors who look after them diligently.

5. Pray for the elderly parents of our brothers & sisters, especially those living far away. Pray for God's care and protection!

6. Pray for the brothers & sisters looking for work. May God open doors for them and provide for their daily needs!

7. We do not have enough space for running simultaneous onsite gatherings. May God provide more space and larger venues for a variety of our ministries!

8. May the Lord provide more helpers to welcome newcomers and help them know our church better!

9. Pray for the Bible teaching and discipleship training ministries. May God bring in more teachers & instructors, so that the life of brothers and sisters can continuously be renewed and sanctified by God's word.

10. Pray that God will provide more helpers to share the heavy load of our diverse ministries in evangelism and mission

11. Pray to ask God to bind Satan and block the destructive works, strengthen the faith of brothers & sisters, and help them stay alert in prayers.

2. Pray that the Lord will prepare sufficient volunteers to help packing and delivering the gift packs on 18 May. May God use this community service to bless the local Jews in need!

Day 3: Global Missions – HKBM – Rev. & Mrs Sung

1. Give thanks to God that we have returned to our mission field safely. But with the start of the spring season, Pastor Sung began to suffer from itchy eyes caused by pollen. May God have mercy and bring healing!

2. Pray for the cooperation of a new team of leaders and pastors at Hannover and Clough. May the Lord give us a spirit of unity to work with one another in the advancement of the gospel work of the church/bible study class!

3. Pray for all the members of the church/bible study class who are under stress in their studies, work and families. May our Lord help all of us to be guided and comforted by the word of God, and to continue to walk by faith in the Lord!

Day 4: Pray for Christians under Persecutions

Around the world, persecutions directed at Christians are becoming more blatant. Please read the 2023 World Watch List and pray earnestly for the Christians in Mali which ranks **#17** on the list of the 50 most dangerous countries to follow Jesus.

Day 5: Pray for People in Sufferings around the World

2. The pandemic has impacted children all over the world, especially in those poverty-stricken countries. May God protect them, secure them from danger and enable them to continue their studies, so that their growth will not be stunted!

Pray for Australia

1. Many people are impacted mentally and emotionally by the pandemic, and psychiatrists are already seeing more people seeking help. May the Lord have mercy and give them peace!

2. Pray for the economic situation and livelihood of all people in Australia.

3. Pray for the federal & state governments of Australia. May the leaders fear God, act according to biblical truth and values, and govern the country with wisdom and love for people!

Day 6: Pray for the Nations and People

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people. (Proverbs 14:34)

- Pray for the leaders of all the nations. May they fear God; act according to biblical truth and values; govern their countries with wisdom and love for their people, so that people can live peacefully and steadily with godliness and solemnness, and come to know Lord Jesus!

- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's righteousness and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness! - Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people.

- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.
- Pray for the island nations in the South Pacific.

- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan and East Asia.

- Pray for a variety of global situations & needs.



Day 7: Great Souls at Prayer 2023 (18)

We ask you to fill us more and more with that pity for others' troubles, which comes from forgetfulness of our own, and fill us with the glad hope of the children of eternity. And to You, the Beginning and the End, Lord of the living, Refuge of the dying, we give thanks and praise for ever – Amen.

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
