Day 1: Pray for CCBC

- 1. Pray for the renewal and growth of various ministries. May God guide our way and provide what is needed!

- 9. Pray that God will provide more helpers to share the heavy load of our diverse mission ministries.
- 10. Pray to ask God to bind Satan and block the destructive works, strengthen the faith of brothers & sisters, and help them stay alert.

- 1. Thanks be to God! The Moon Festival Care for Elderly Operation has finished well. Please pray for the care and follow up of our new friends.
- 2. May the Lord move more brothers & sisters to participate in CareNet's caring and serving, while following Lord Jesus' example in loving the sick, and walking with them, to bring the Lord's love into their lives.
- 3. May the Lord use the "Walk Together Carer's Training" to equip more brothers and sisters who are interested, so that they can more effectively serve in ministries of caring and visiting.

Day 3: Global Missions -

Anna (HKBM – Local cross-cultural missionary)

Thanksgiving and prayer points:

- 1. Pray that the "Home of Love and Grace" can invite new Indonesian domestic helpers to enrol in the Gospel English classes, and more domestic helpers would make use of the recreational centre.
- 2. Pray for the various preparation for the Indonesian Youth Fun Day on 29/10. Pray that God will bless this event, provide guidance and inspire more churches to participate, and that we can serve at least 500 Indonesian helpers.
- 3. May God provide 2-3 more Indonesian missionaries to accommodate the needs of the ministry development.
- 4. Give thanks that Anna had the opportunity in late August to visit North Thailand, her previous mission field, and the house churches in the villages. Give thanks that the Thai believers were able to stand firm in their faith despite pressure from relatives and friends. Pray for the various difficulties in life and challenges in faith that they face. May God provide for their needs and strengthen their faith.

Day 4: Christians under Persecutions

Around the world, persecutions directed at Christians are becoming more blatant. Please read the 2023 World Watch List and pray earnestly for the Christians in **Tunisia** which ranks **#36** on the list of the 50 most dangerous countries to follow Jesus.

Day 5: People in Sufferings around the World

Pray for the global pandemic situation:

More than 800 million people have been infected with COVID-19 worldwide, and more than 7 million people have lost their lives since the beginning of the pandemic. May the Lord have mercy!

- 1. May God give wisdom to the medical researchers, so that the vaccines and other medications can be effective in fighting against new variants!
- 2. The pandemic has impacted children all over the world, especially in those poverty-stricken countries. May God protect them, secure them from danger and enable them to continue their education, so that their growth will not be stunted!

Pray for Australia

- 1. Many people are impacted mentally and emotionally by the pandemic, and psychiatrists are already seeing more people seeking help. May the Lord have mercy and give them peace!
- 2. Pray for the economic situation and livelihood of all people in Australia.
- 3. Pray for the federal & state governments of Australia. May the leaders fear God, act according to biblical truth and values, and govern the country with wisdom and love for people!

Day 6: Pray for the Nations and People Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people. (Proverbs 14:34)

- Pray for the leaders of all the nations. May they fear God; act according to biblical truth and values; govern their countries with wisdom and love for their people, so that people can live peacefully and steadily with godliness and solemnness, and come to know Lord Jesus!
- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's righteousness

and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness!

- Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people.
- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.
- Pray for the island nations in the South Pacific.
- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan and East Asia.
- Pray for a variety of global situations & needs.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior. (1 Timothy 2:1-3)
