### Day 1: Pray for CCBC

1. Pray for the renewal and growth of various ministries. May God guide our way and provide what is needed!

2. Pray for the families of the sick and the elderly who are unwell. Pray that their suffering will be lessened, and they will have the strength from God to face it. We also ask the Lord to add more love, patience and faith to their families, and in Him they will find strength and comfort to look after and accompany the sick.

3. Pray for the Christmas outreach at the nursing homes in December. Pray that God will guide its preparations and encourage brothers & sisters to join in to share God's love and blessings to the elderly people.

### Day 3: Global Missions – Fare East Broadcasting Company (FEBC) – Southeast Asia

## Day 5: People in Sufferings around the World

Pray for the global pandemic situation:

More than 800 million people have been infected with COVID-19 worldwide, and more than 7 million people have lost their lives since the beginning of the pandemic. May the Lord have mercy!

1. May God give wisdom to the medical researchers, so that the vaccines and other medications can be effective in fighting against new variants!

2. The pandemic has impacted children all over the world, especially in those poverty-stricken countries. May God protect them, secure them from danger and enable them to continue their education, so that their growth will not be stunted!

#### Pray for Australia

1. Many people are impacted mentally and emotionally by the pandemic, and psychiatrists are already seeing more people seeking help. May the Lord have mercy and give them peace!

2. Pray for the economic situation and livelihood of all people in Australia.

3. Pray for the federal & state governments of Australia. May the leaders fear God, act according to biblical truth and values, and govern the country with wisdom and love for people!

### Day 6: Pray for the Nations and People

**Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people.** (Proverbs 14:34)

- Pray for the leaders of all the nations. May they fear God; act according to biblical truth and values; govern their countries with wisdom and love for their people, so that people can live peacefully and steadily with godliness and solemnness, and come to know Lord Jesus!

- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's righteousness and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness!

- Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people.

- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.

- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan and East Asia, and the island nations in the South Pacific.

- Pray for the global situations, especially in the Middle East.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior. (1 Timothy 2:1-3)

### Day 7: Great Souls at Prayer 2023 (43)
