Day 1: Pray for CCBC

- 1. Pray for the renewal and growth of various ministries. May God guide our way and provide what is needed!
- 2. Pray that God will use the discipleship life practices (spiritual disciplines) in each zone this year, so that brothers & sisters walk in Christ, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, abounding in thanksgiving.
- 3. Pray for the evangelism and gospel outreach of our zones. May we experience more of God's grace this year, and lead more people to Christ!
- 4. Pray for our pastors, leaders & helpers serving diligently in various ministries. May God guard them and their families, keep them well and increase their wisdom, faith & perseverance.
- 5. Pray for the elderly parents of our brothers and sisters, especially those living far away. Pray for God's care and protection!
- 6. Pray for the brothers & sisters looking for work. May God open doors for them and provide for their daily needs!

- 7. Pray to God for more space and larger venues for a variety of our ministries!
- 8. May the Lord provide more helpers to welcome newcomers and help them know our church better!
- 9. Pray that God will provide more helpers to share the heavy load of our diverse mission ministries.
- 10. Pray to ask God to bind Satan and block the destructive works, strengthen the faith of brothers & sisters, and help them stay alert.

- 1. Pray for the plannings and preparations of campus ministries at various universities in 2024. May the Lord provide enough manpower in the ministry to share the Gospel with the students.
- 2. Pray for the preparation of a Cooking Class. Pray that God will use this to reach out to non-believers in the community and witness His love.

Day 3: Global Missions -

FEBC (Ethnic People Groups, South-east Asia)

- 1. "If I didn't have your programs. I would've ended my life. I came to know the Lord through FEBC. Now my life is very different." Facebook Live viewer, Laos.
- 2. Pray for FEBC's ministry on-air, online and on ground in 17 languages to ethnic people groups in Thailand, Laos, Vietnam, and Myanmar.
- 3. Praise God for the 2,796 baptisms in 2022. Pray for these new disciples to make more disciples. (Matthew 28:19)
- 4. Pray for the Shan in northern Myanmar who have received shortwave radios and SD cards with Shan language programs.
- 5. Praise God for 13.5 million views on Facebook and 1.1 million views on YouTube. Pray for decisions for Christ and disciples to be raised up.
- 6. Thank God for the humble leaders who tirelessly share the Good News to their own people. Pray for them and their families.
- 7. Pray for God to raise up new leaders and disciple-makers among the youth. May they live out their Christ-centered identity and purpose.
- 8. The start of Advent. Pray for believers to intentionally focus on Christ, and His First and Second Coming. Do follow FEBC's Facebook page for devotions.

Day 4: Christians under Persecutions

Around the world, persecutions directed at Christians are becoming more blatant. Please read the 2023 World Watch List and pray earnestly for the Christians in Cameroon which ranks #45 on the list of the 50 most dangerous countries to follow Jesus.

Day 5: People in Sufferings around the world Pray for the global pandemic situation:

More than 800 million people have been infected with COVID-19 worldwide, and more than 7 million people have lost their lives since the beginning of the pandemic. May the Lord have mercy!

- 1. May God give wisdom to the medical researchers, so that the vaccines and other medications can be effective in fighting against new variants!
- 2. The pandemic has impacted children all over the world, especially in those poverty-stricken countries. May God protect them, secure them from danger and enable them to continue their education, so that their growth will not be stunted!

Pray for Australia

- 1. Many people are impacted mentally and emotionally by the pandemic, and psychiatrists are already seeing more people seeking help. May the Lord have mercy and give them peace!
- 2. Pray for the economic situation and livelihood of all people in Australia.
- 3. Pray for the federal & state governments of Australia. May the leaders fear God, act according to biblical truth and values, and govern the country with wisdom and love for people!

<u>Day 6: Pray for the Nations and People</u> *Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people.* (Proverbs 14:34)

- Pray for the leaders of all the nations. May they fear God; act according to biblical truth and values; govern their countries with wisdom and love for their people, so that people can live peacefully and steadily with godliness and solemnness, and come to know Lord Jesus!
- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's righteousness and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness!

- Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people.
- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.
- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan and East Asia, and the island nations in the South Pacific.
- Pray for the global situations, especially in the Middle East.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Saviour. (1 Timothy 2:1-3)

Day 7: Great Souls at Prayer 2023 (46)

O Lord, Strength of our life, may You be, I entreat You, our Strength unto life eternal; our Strength when temptation assails us, for You are stronger than our strongest enemy; our Strength when we go down into the valley of the shadow of death, for the last enemy that shall be destroyed in death. By Your Rod and Your Staff comfort us – Amen.

Pray for ourselves so that we can experience God every day:
