Day 1: Pray for CCBC

1. Pray for the renewal and growth of various ministries. May God guide our way and provide what is needed!

2. Pray that God will use the discipleship life practices in each zone this year, so that brothers & sisters walk in Christ, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, abounding in thanksgiving.

3. Pray for the evangelism and gospel outreach of our zones. May we experience more of God's grace this year, and lead more people to Christ!

4. Pray for our pastors, leaders & helpers serving diligently in various ministries. May God guard them and their families, keep them well and increase their wisdom, faith & perseverance.

Day 2: Global & Local Missions Chinese Christian Mission Australia - CCMA

1. Thank God for driving us to develop online ministries during the pandemic, enabling us and the elderly overseas Chinese to learn new technologies and stay connected online. May God strengthen the team and serve with Jesus as the center!

2. Thank God that words are a silent form of evangelism. By sending out various publications, the Gospel of Jesus can reach small towns and bring encouragement to the homes of believers. Pray that God moves hearts and allows more people to be involved in the various works of written evangelism.

3. CCMA's main overseas mission fields currently include Santo and Vila in Vanuatu. Pray for God's protection over the missionaries of CCMA and for the sending of more workers willing to shepherd the local flock.

4. During the pandemic, our organisation attempted to start online English classes. From our trained teachers, we have recruited 8 volunteers to carry out this ministry, providing instruction in Mandarin. Since October 2021, we have enrolled a total of 78 students, including 36 non-believers!

Day 3: Christians under Persecutions

Around the world, persecutions directed at Christians are becoming more blatant. Please read the 2024 World Watch List and pray earnestly for the Christians in Libya which ranks **#3** on the list of the 50 most dangerous countries to follow Jesus.

Pray for Australia

1. Many people are impacted mentally and emotionally by the pandemic, and psychiatrists are already seeing more people seeking help. May the Lord have mercy and give them peace!

2. Pray for the economic situation and livelihood of all people in Australia.

3. Pray for the federal & state governments of Australia. May the leaders fear God, act according to biblical truth and values, and govern the country with wisdom and love for people!

Day 5: Great Souls at Prayer 2024 (3)
