Day 1: Pray for CCBC

- 1. Pray for the renewal and growth of various ministries. May God guide our way and provide what is needed!
- 2. Pray that God will use the discipleship life practices in each zone this year, so that brothers & sisters walk in Christ, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, abounding in thanksgiving.
- 3. Pray for the evangelism and gospel outreach of our zones. May we experience more of God's grace this year, and lead more people to Christ!

Day 2: Global & Local Missions

<u>Anna (HKBM – Local Cross-Cultural Missionary)</u> <u>Service Community: Indonesian</u>

- 1. Give thanks to the Lord! God provided two Indonesian co-workers when we desperately needed Indonesian pastoral staff to develop our ministry. God opened doors in their visa applications which were approved within two weeks and four weeks respectively. They started their work on 1 December, focusing on pastoral care for and outreach to the Indonesian domestic helpers. Pray that God will continue to provide for all our needs!
- 2. Pray for the new co-workers, Yun and Ice, so that they can adapt to new environment; and learn Cantonese (Yun). Pray for good communication and excellent partnership between Anna and the new co-workers.
- 3. Pray for the development of the Indonesian Gospel Ministry in HKBM. Indonesian domestic helpers are the second largest group of foreign domestic helpers in Hong Kong after the Filipinos. Most of them are Muslim, in need of the Gospel.
- 4. We hope that our outreach events will not only bring a moment of happiness to the domestic helpers, but also provide opportunities for follow up and care. HKBM is actively promoting and lining up the local churches in developing Indonesian domestic helper ministry on a district-by-district basis. At present, HKBM is planning to kick start Indonesian domestic helper ministry in four districts, namely, Kowloon East, Kowloon West, New Territories East and Hong Kong Island East. By doing so, we hope to consolidate resources; expand God's kingdom; and live out the good testimony for Jesus. Pray for the Lord's guidance in this multi-district ministry.

Day 3: Christians under Persecutions

Around the world, persecutions directed at Christians are becoming more blatant. Please read the 2024 World Watch List and pray earnestly for the Christians in **Yemen** which ranks **#5** on the list of the 50 most dangerous countries to follow Jesus.
