Day 1: Pray for CCBC

1. Pray for the renewal and expansion of various ministries of our church, may the Lord lead and provide all that is needed!

2. May the Lord use the discipleship life practices in each zone this year, so that the spiritual life of brothers & sisters may be rooted and built up in Christ, with unwavering faith and a grateful heart.

Day 2: Global & Local Missions

3. For different reasons, some leading and key co-workers will temporarily leave Montpellier in April. We and some other co-workers have to take up their serving roles. Pray that God will give humble and united hearts for serving together during this period.

4. Pray for two students who just accepted Christ in Montpellier. They are eager to seek God and want to stay in Montpellier. They regard our church as their home. They are encountering difficulties in applying for schools. May God open doors for them.

1. Pray for Barry and his co-workers in reaching out to the Jewish people.

2. Pray for their discipleship training program for the spiritual growth of Jewish believers.

3. Pray for Tikkun Olam's work in helping the poor.

Day 4: Pray for Nations and People

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people. (Proverbs 14:34)

- Pray for the leaders of all the nations. May they fear God; act according to biblical truth and values; govern their countries with wisdom and love for their people, so that people can live peacefully and steadily with godliness and solemnness, and come to know Lord Jesus!

- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's holiness & righteousness and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness!

- Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people.

- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.

- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan, East Asia, and the island nations in the South Pacific.

- Pray for the global situations, especially in the Middle East.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Saviour. (1 Timothy 2:1-3)

Pray for ourselves so that we can experience God every day:

- 1. Read the Bible every day and meditate on God's Word.
- 2. Retreat to a quiet place to spend time with God, listen carefully to His still small voice, and wait for His instruction and correction with a humble and open heart.
- 3. Live out God's Word in our daily life and experience the presence of God.

4. Watch carefully in our daily life for God's guidance, and then follow Him wholeheartedly to complete God's assignment so that we can experience God profoundly.

Day 5: Great Souls at Prayer 2024 (12)

Eternal and most glorious God, don't let me undervalue myself as to give away my soul. Nothing in the world is more precious than the soul.

Keep my soul, my Lord, because it belongs to You, and keep my body where my soul dwells in.
