Day 1: Pray for CCBC

- 1. Pray for the renewal and development of various ministries of our church, may the Lord lead and provide all that is needed!
- 2. May the Lord provide more and larger spaces for various ministries to use, as there is a shortage of meeting places!
- 3. May the Lord use the discipleship life practices in each zone this year, so that the spiritual life of brothers & sisters may be rooted and built up in Christ, with unwavering faith and a grateful heart.

<u>Day 2: Global & Local Missions</u> <u>FEBC (Hong Kong)</u>

- 1. **Programme Changes** There are plans to revamp several existing programs. May God help the team to find a way forward for these programs. Pray for wisdom especially under the situation of limited manpower and resources, so that the team members will adapt well and be ready for the changes. May the audience greatly benefit from the updated programs.
- 2. **Building-up Workers** Over the years, more than 20,000 students have enrolled in the traditional programs of Liangyou Bible Seminary, with over 5,000 graduates as at end of last year. Currently, there are more than 40,000 registered users on the new self-learning platform. Our co-workers endeavour to address the needs of these users and update the programs accordingly. Pray for God's provision for the platform construction; and the necessary manpower for future development.
- 3. **Use of Equipment** Pray for smooth operation of the recording studios and equipment. Several technical issues have arisen during previous live broadcasts and recordings. Our co-workers are currently collaborating with suppliers to solve these issues. Pray for quick resolution of issues and smooth live broadcasts and recordings.

Day 3: Christians under Persecutions

Day 4: Pray for Nations and People

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people. (Proverbs 14:34)

- Pray for the leaders of all the nations. May they fear God; act according to biblical truth and values; govern their countries with wisdom and love for their people, so that people can live peacefully and steadily with godliness and solemnness, and come to know Lord Jesus!
- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's holiness & righteousness and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness!
- Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people.
- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.
- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan, East Asia, and the island nations in the South Pacific.
- Pray for the global situations, especially in the Middle East.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Saviour. (1 Timothy 2:1-3)

Pray for ourselves so that we can experience God every day:

- Read the Bible every day and meditate on God's Word.
- 2. Retreat to a quiet place to spend time with God, listen carefully to His still small voice, and wait for His instruction and correction with a humble and open heart.
- 3. Live out God's Word in our daily life and experience the presence of God.
- 4. Watch carefully in our daily life for God's guidance, and then follow Him wholeheartedly to complete God's assignment so that we can experience God profoundly.

Day 5: Great Souls at Prayer 2024 (25)

When we are awake, we are still with you, O God most merciful, and your hand is over us for good. May you be the Desire of our hearts, and the Ruler of our thoughts.
