#### **Day 1: Pray for CCBC**

activities for September. Please pray for the Lord to grant us enough wisdom, strength, and stamina to complete our work, to have a good partnership with our fellow workers and brothers and sisters, and to bear a good testimony for the Lord.

- 2. This year, the French church in Montpellier signed a new rental agreement with us. It has significant changes compared to the previous one. We need some adaptation and adjustments. Pray for the Lord to provide our needs and to continue to bless us with a good relationship and collaboration with the French church, so that we may prosper the gospel together.
- 3. Recently, many key co-workers have been facing great work pressure & difficulties, including the stress of not being able to find a job. Pray that God will strengthen their faith, help them continue to rely on God in difficult times, and to have a heart of peace and joy.
- 4. Pray for Maggie's health. She is currently undergoing treatment. Please pray for the Lord's healing.

#### **Day 3: Christians under Persecutions**

Around the world, persecutions directed at Christians are becoming more blatant. Please read the 2024 World Watch List and pray earnestly for the Christians in **Nicaragua** which ranks #30 on the list of the 50 most dangerous countries to follow Jesus.

Christian leaders have been harassed and arrested; Christian schools, television stations and charities have been closed, and churches are constantly monitored and intimidated. Last Easter, the police banned all processions during the Holy Week.

- May the gospel be widely spread so that more people turn to Jesus! May God's holiness & righteousness and truth be manifested in this era of chaos and darkness!
- Pray for the global economic situation and livelihood of all people.
- Pray for the war in Ukraine and the refugees.
- Pray for the situations in Hong Kong, Taiwan, East Asia, and the island nations in the South Pacific.
- Pray for the global situations, especially in the Middle East.

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Saviour. (1 Timothy 2:1-3)

## Pray for ourselves so that we can experience God every day:

- Read the Bible every day and meditate on God's Word.
- 2. Retreat to a quiet place to spend time with God, listen carefully to His still small voice, and wait for His instruction and correction with a humble and open heart.
- 3. Live out God's Word in our daily life and experience the presence of God.
- 4. Watch carefully in our daily life for God's guidance, and then follow Him wholeheartedly to complete God's assignment so that we can experience God profoundly.

## Day 5: Great Souls at Prayer 2024 (30)

O Lord, You give Your great love to this world, and reconciled earth to heaven through Your only Son.
